In addition to our annual COR Leadership Retreat and National Leadership Summit, the success of the BYX Foundation also allowed us to partner with Chic-Fil-A to host the first ever President's Circle Retreat at Winshape Camps outside of Atlanta, Georgia. In addition to all of our leadership initiatives, we expanded to another Big Ten school by initiating our newest chapter at Ohio State University.

FORGING AHEAD:

In order to position ourselves to continue to grow and reach our potential, the Board of Directors approved two new positions for our national staff. This summer, we hired Nick McGaha to be our Director of Expansion as well as Connor Callison to be Director of Media. Nick will be focused on continuing to develop a new vision and structure for expansion as we look to establish BYX Colonies that will build flourishing and self-sustaining BYX chapters throughout the country.
