LETTER FROM THE FRATERNITY PRESIDENT

MISSION:

Research continues to reveal the devastating statistic that roughly 66% of college students walk away from their faith. For the past thirty-seven years, BYX has stood as a solution for college men seeking a fraternal brotherhood experience that grows their relationship with Jesus Christ. Through the avenue of social fraternity on a college campus, young men experience life-changing brotherhood and unity in Christ. Not only does BYX stop college men from walking away from their faith – we believe BYX is developing the next generation of Godly men for lifelong kingdom impact in their families, churches, workplaces, and communities.

YEAR IN REVIEW:

Remembering what God has helped us overcome, this past year was our chance to embrace a fresh experience of brotherhood. Emerging out of COVID was challenging but gave us greater resilience, hope, and dependence on God. Looser restrictions on college campuses brought the much-needed opportunity to reestablish regular in-person connection. BYX safely returned to full capacity in-person operations (chapter meetings, cell groups, social events, etc). The National Staff was able to reconnect with our members and refresh our vision for brotherhood and unity in Christ. We traveled to every campus, expanded to Georgia Southern, recolonized at Sam Houston State, hosted an in-person NLS

for the first time in 2-years, held our 4th annual President's Circle in Washington DC, held our first annual Pledge Captain/Chaplain Circle at Winshape Retreats, and took 36 guys to Dallas and Israel through our annual COR Leadership Retreat. Through all of this, this year gave us a fresh reminder of how truly good and pleasant it is when brothers dwell together in unity.

After years of following Brian Lee, a leader I love and respect, I've received the honor and privilege of serving as Fraternity President. I commit to leading this fraternity into everything God has for us this year and in years to come. NATIONAL LEADERSHIP SUMMIT

The Foundation supported our annual NLS with a \$66,475.70 grant to inspire and train our 250+ newly elected officers from our 31 chapters and 6 colonies. Additionally, we virtually connected our 15 (at the time) Alumni Chapters to their newly elected officers.

PRESIDENT'S CIRCLE

All 31 chapters and 6 colonies President received leadership training thanks to the \$98,625 raised during our GivingTuesday campaign in 2021 for all three “circle” retreats.

MEMBER SCHOLARSHIPS

The Foundation provided 223 brothers with \$92,700 in scholarships to afford them the opportunity of BYX. That is 91 more brothers and \$38,700 more than last year!

PLEDGE CAPTAIN & CHAPLAIN'S CIRCLE

74 Pledge Captains and Chaplains from all 31 BYX chapters and 6 colonies received leadership training thanks to the \$98,625 raised during our GivingTuesday campaign in 2021 for all three “circle” retreats.
